## TRACKIT LIGHTS

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you had a wonderful break and your child has settled back into the new term? It's been wonderful to welcome the children back this week and to see them looking smart with an excellent attitude to learning.

You'll be aware of the current 'Omicron' picture in the media and the situation continues to be a challenge for us in school. I am grateful for your support in helping to keep all members of our school community as safe as possible over the coming weeks.

We will continue to inform all classes by text message if there is a positive PCR case. However, in light of the new government guidance from 11th January, we will also inform you via text if there is a positive LFD Test. The guidance advises that all other children in the class, because they have been a close contact, LFD test at home each day for 7 days. A reminder that we are unable to share the adult or child that has tested positive so please respect this privacy.

We are hoping for the minimum of disruption and a successful term but that does rely on us all regularly LFD Testing twice a week and wearing a mask indoors unless exempt. You should all have received the term dates for 2022/23. today. Please check you junk/spam folder if this is not the case. These have been agreed by the Governing Body and apply to the new academic year in September. These term dates are in line with Stockport LA's stated school holidays for 2022/23 and include our five INSET days.
