
## AND FINALLY.....

# Family Support Vouchers

Help for families with school-age children

As part of Stockport Council's delivery of the Department for Work and Pensions' Household Support Fund, vouchers are being issued to families with school-age children who receive income-based free school meals, those in early years with equivalent eligibility, and those households in receipt of Local Council Tax Support and/or Housing Benefit paid by Stockport Council.

Eligible families are receiving a **Family Support Voucher** worth **£97.50 per eligible child,** which can be redeemed at a Post Office®. The voucher is to help with the cost of household energy and other household essentials.














# In the news this week

has become the most expensive artwork ever auctioned in Europe. The painting, called Lady with a Fan, sold for the final price of £85.3m at Sotheby's in London. It was sold to an art collector from Hong Kong, with three other bidders hoping to buy the piece. When Klimt died in 1918, the portrait of the unnamed woman was still on an easel in his studio. The estimated sale price was a much lower £65m, which bidders quickly went over, and the painting sold in just 10 minutes.
