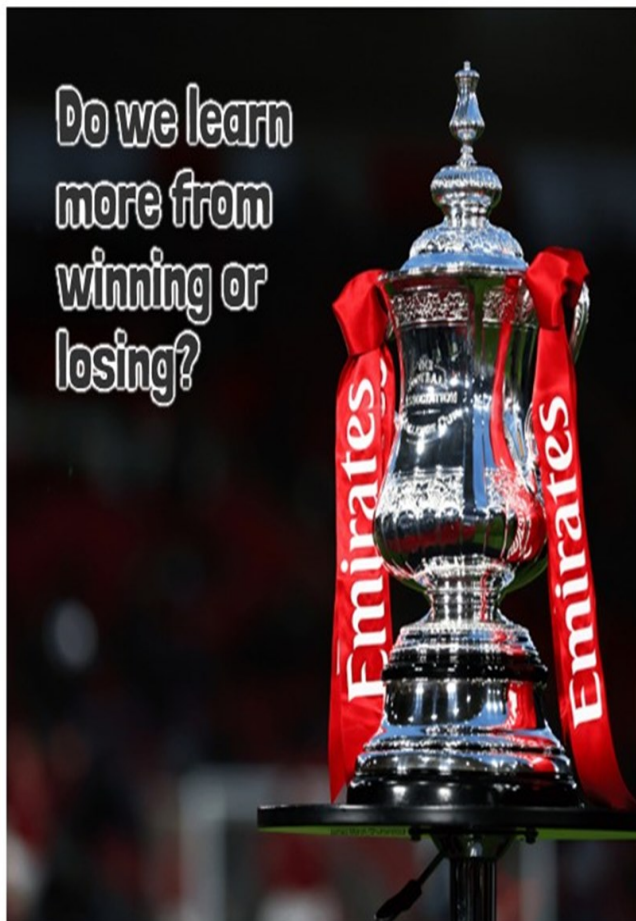


## In the news this week

- > Talk together about how you believe we should behave when you lose.



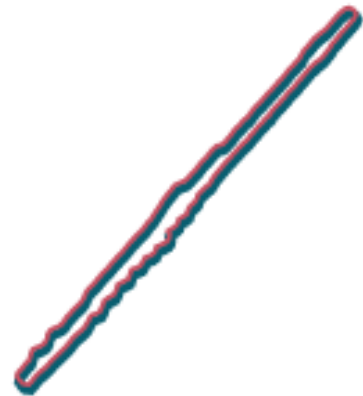

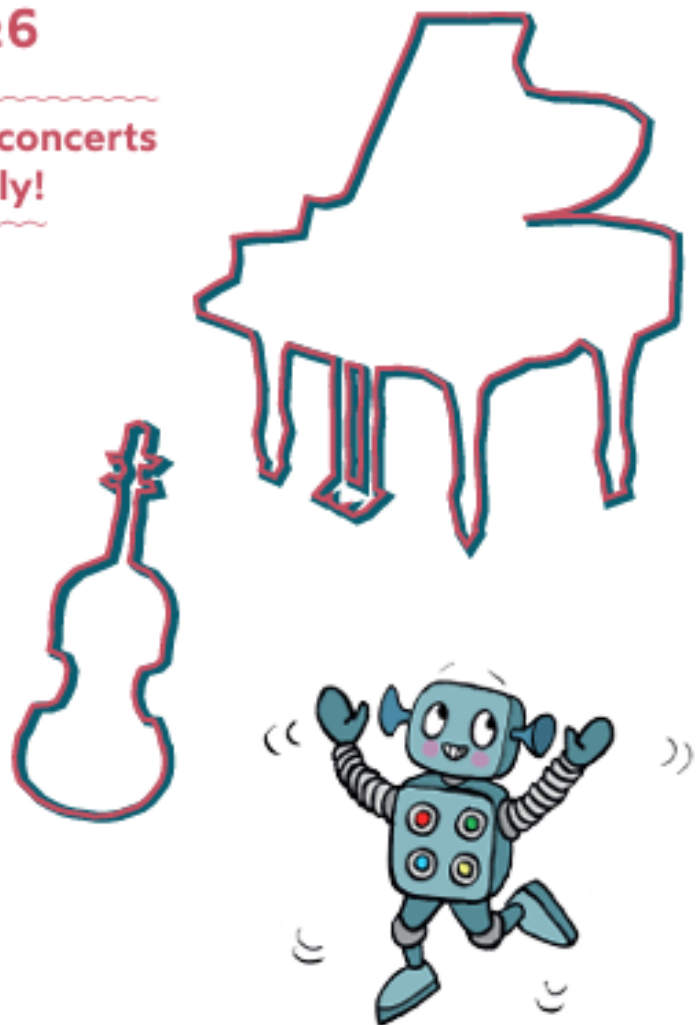

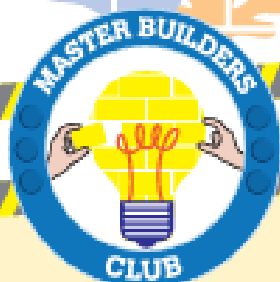
