


In the news this week

30 years ago, on 30th April 1993, Swiss science company CERN opened up the World Wide Web to the world, free-ofcharge. The 'collaborative information system' was being used by the scientists at CERN (the European Organisation for Nuclear Research) to communicate, without delay, across countries and continents but deciding that there could be wider uses for the tool, they made it available for everyone.
