Many of you who have children in Reception and Key Stage 1 access the <u>Universal</u> Free School Meals which are available to all KS1 children. Since the introduction of the universal free meals many parents have stopped applying for free school meals until their child is in KS2. However this current situation may be leaving you unable to access free school meals when you may be entitled. If your child is in Reception or KS1 and you are currently out of work or in receipt of benefits you need to contact our School Business Manager, Sarah Allen, sarah.allen@moorfield.stockport.sch.uk who can explain the application process. You could be missing out on the national free school meal vouchers of £15 per child per week whilst schools are closed.

We are expecting an announcement from the Prime Minister next week on plans for the country moving forward including plans for schools. The Secretary of State for Education, Gavin Williams, has shared this week:

"We recognise that the idea of schools all returning on day one with the full complement of pupils is not realistic or practical... I do expect schools to be opened in a phased manner. I also intend to be giving schools as much notice as possible."

I hope the Prime Minster makes this clearer to us all in the coming days.
