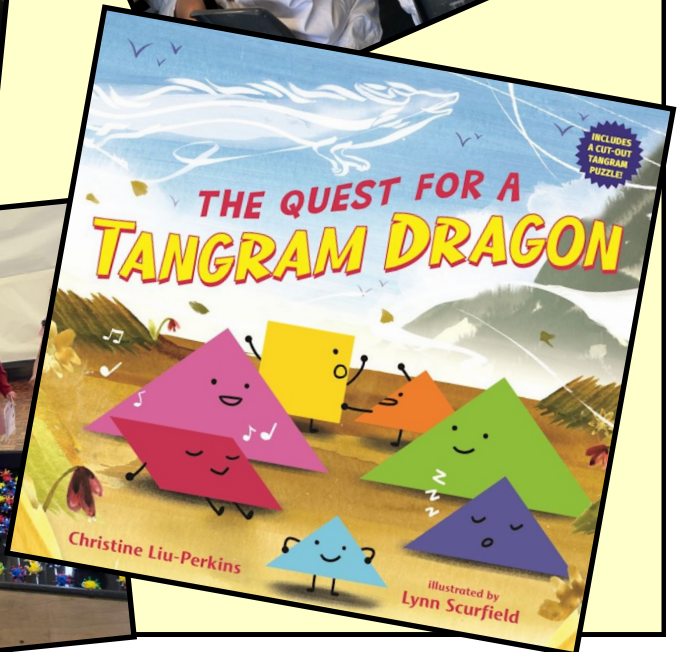
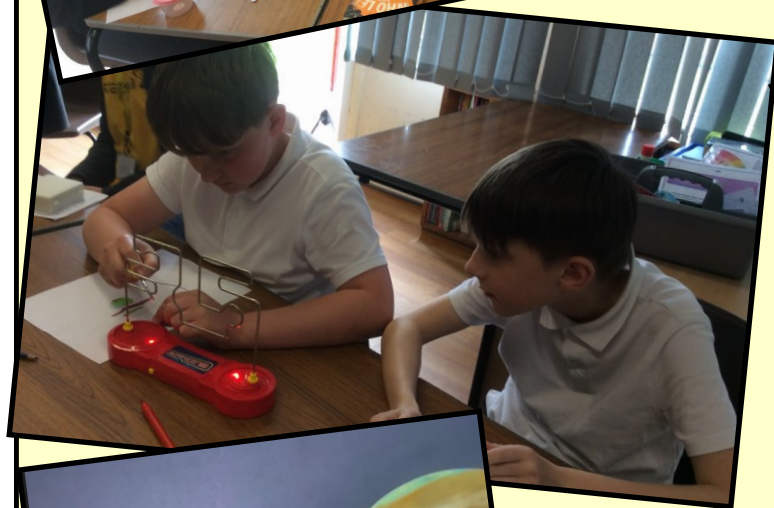
OFSTED INSPECTION

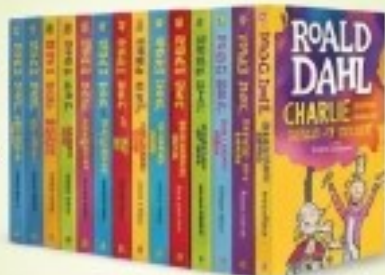

- > What are some ways we can show respect for other people's traditions?




