YEAR 6 INFORMATION - IS YOUR CHILD MOVING TO SECONDARY SCHOOL THIS SEPTEMBER?

Apply for an igo card in plenty of time to keep on paying child fares on buses & trams. Get everything you need at: beenetwork.com/schools

Igo card applications and summer drop-in sessions

If you're 11-16 years old you'll need an [igo card](#) to travel using child tickets on buses and trams in Greater Manchester. It can take up to two weeks to process your igo card application, so make sure you apply in plenty of time for the start of the new term.

The Bee Network team is on hand to help at five pop-up stalls at [interchanges](#) across Greater Manchester this summer. Simply drop by between 12pm – 5pm to speak to staff and get your application in early:

- 28th July – Stockport
- 4th August – Shudehill
- 11th August – Bolton
- 18th August – Altrincham*
- 25th August – Bury

**Altrincham Interchange will be offering additional support Monday 17, Wednesday 19, Thursday 20 and Friday 21 August – 10am-2pm*

Make sure you bring:

- A passport-sized colour photo of the child that's applying.
- Proof of name and age of the child applying: a copy of your birth certificate, adoption certificate, medical card, passport or EU/EEA card. Please do not bring original documents.
- Payment for the £10 fee – card only.

We are also saying goodbye to Mrs Dalton, who has worked in our Resource Base for the last couple of years. We wish her all the best as she moves on to work in a special school setting.

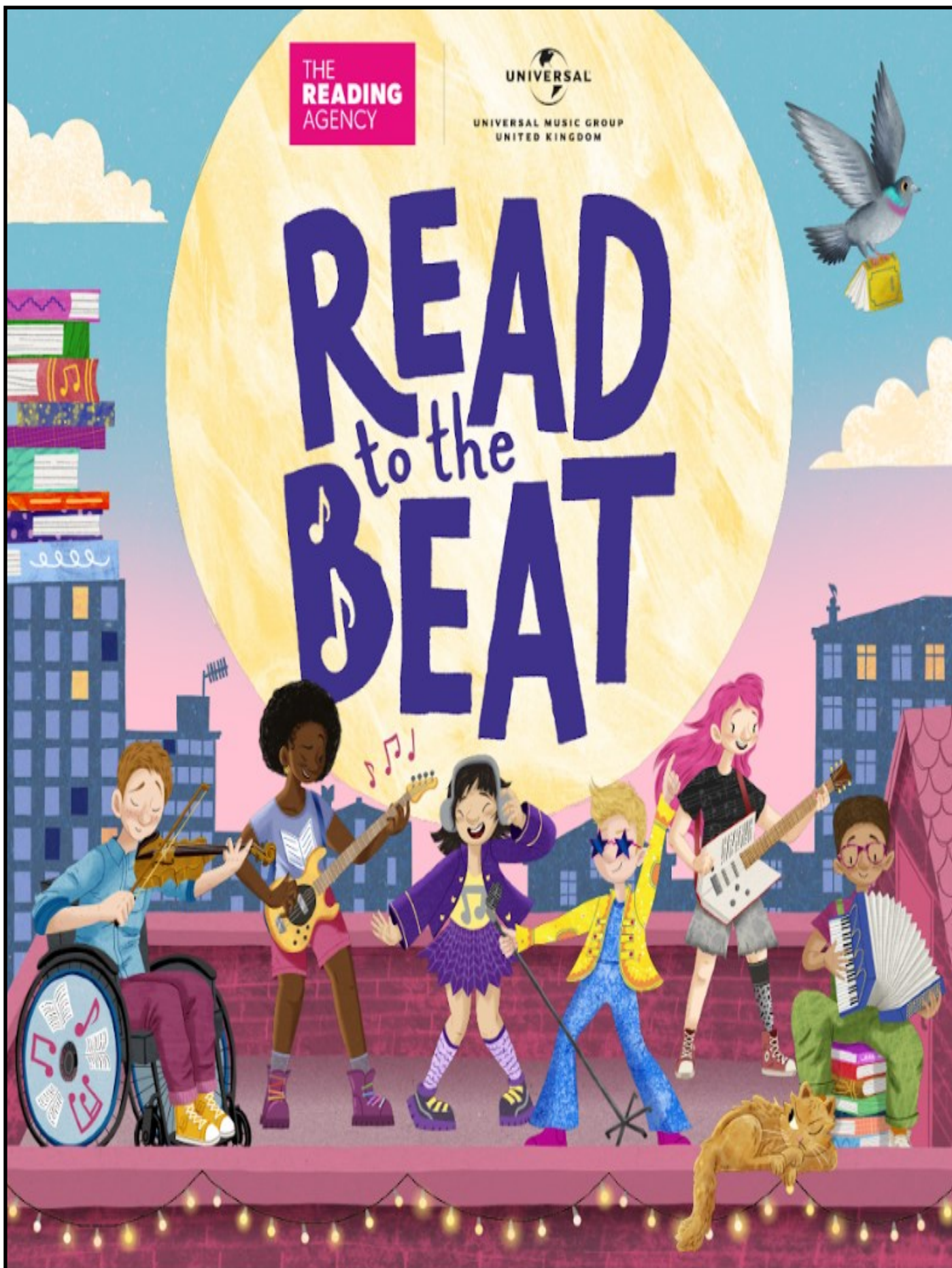
AND FINALLY ...THE END OF THE SCHOOL YEAR
