



REWARDING POSITIVE BEHAVIOURS FOR LEARNING

- **Praise and acknowledgement** through the electronic 'Trackit Lights' behaviour programme (green strengths)
- **Informing parents and carers** (email, telephone call, text, class dojo).
- **Individual class reward systems**

Weekly Achievement Assembly

- **Personal Achievement Award** (weekly celebration of academic, creative or well-being work and examples to be brought to assembly if appropriate).
- **Class of the Week** (weekly celebration of the class who achieve the highest percentage of Trackit Lights strengths for the week. A certificate will be presented and the winning class will receive 15 minutes free time to be banked or taken at an appropriate time as decided by the class teacher).
- **Pupil of the Week** (weekly celebration of the pupil who achieves the highest number of Trackit Lights strengths for the week).
- **Headteacher Award** (weekly celebration of the pupil who has shown an example of the school or British values).

Half Termly Celebration Assembly:

- **Spelling 'Shark' Award, Reading 'Robin' Award, Arithmetic 'Alligator' Award, Handwriting 'Hawk' Award, Home learning 'Hedgehog' Award, Value of the half term Award** (half termly celebration of achievements of pupils that have reached a high standard and can apply core skills across the curriculum. Awards will be presented in celebration assembly and parents and carers will be invited to share in their child's achievement).
