AUTUMN 1 ASSEMBLY

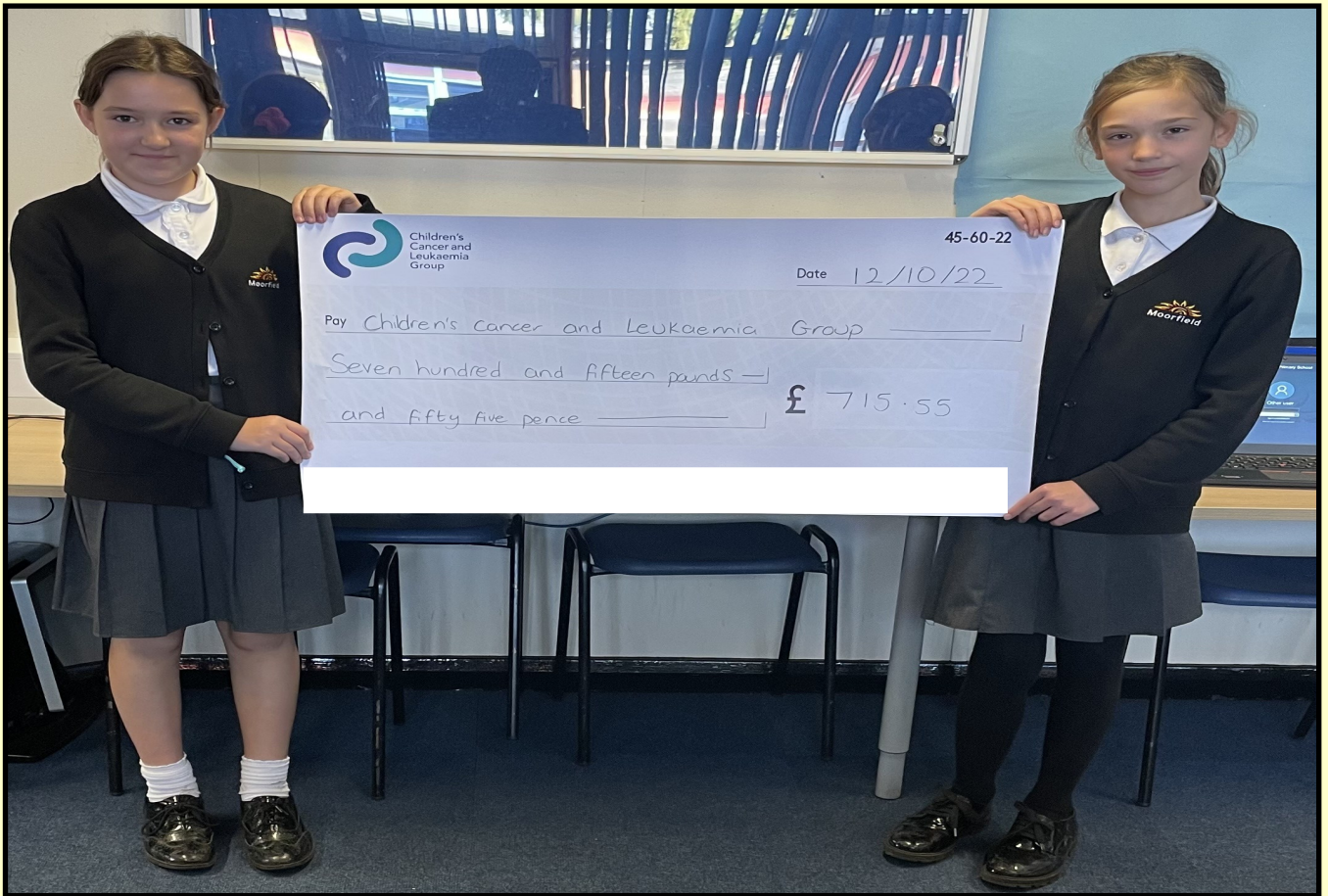
