Pupils eligible for Free School Meals

For those pupils who are eligible for Free School Meals, vouchers will continue to be provided <u>after</u> February half term through the national free school meals voucher scheme. Parents will continue to receive an eCode each week from the provider Edenred.

Vouchers will also be provided over the February half-term holiday. Families of school-age children who are eligible for income-based Free School Meals will receive a £20 voucher per eligible child to help with the costs of food, utilities and other winter essentials.

Families do not need to do anything to apply and will automatically receive a voucher for any child where there is a current income-based free schools meals claim. Where we hold an email address for families, vouchers will be issued by the local authority using the PayPoint system and vouchers will be sent direct from PayPoint to the primary email address for the family. All vouchers will be sent by Friday 12th February and must be redeemed within 3 weeks of issue. Any unredeemed vouchers will expire after 3 weeks to allow funds to be re-invested.

Where we do not hold an email address an Aldi Supermarket voucher will be posted. Subject to receipt of vouchers from Aldi these will be sent out on Friday 12th February by first class post.
