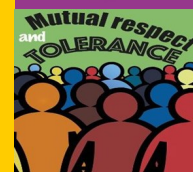

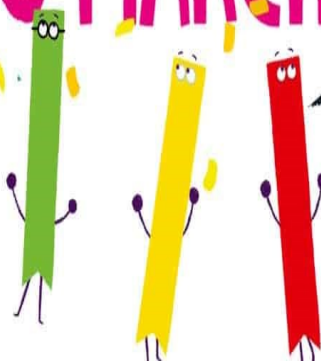
HALF TERM
