Anti-Bullying Policy

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Our School Council Definition:

Bullying is defined as deliberately hurtful behaviour, usually repeated over a period of time, where it is difficult for those bullied to defend themselves.

Pupils will be provided with the opportunity to talk, in confidence, with a member of staff on a one-to-one basis.



Staff and governors will discuss bullying incidents at their meetings in order to maintain awareness and ensure a consistent approach.



Pupils will be made aware of issues surrounding cyber-bullying.

Parents will be informed of the policy and encouraged to bring any incidents of bullying behaviour to the attention of a member of staff.

We will seek to achieve a uniformity of approach between home and school whereby parents and staff will be mutually supportive.



Staff will discuss and agree upon a consistent approach for listening to victims, witnesses and those who bully.
