## The school will do its best to:



- Provide an environment which has been risk assessed in response to the COVID-19 infection;
- Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as we reasonably can;
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs;
- Contact parents/carers if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19;
- Inform you if staff or children in your child's 'bubble' have tested positive for COVID-19 as this may mean your child will need to self-isolate for at least 14 days (your family do not unless your child is symptomatic and/or tests positive).
- Liaise with the local health team when a child or member of staff becomes symptomatic and subsequently tests positive. The school will follow any guidance given by the local health team in this situation;
- Continue our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for children as set out in the Behaviour Policy as well the expectations outlined in this agreement;
- Communicate between home and school through notices, Class Dojo, text, email and the school website.

## To help my child at school, I know and understand that:



- If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, they will self-isolate for 10 days (household for 14 days if test is positive), I will get them tested and I will let the school know as soon as possible via telephone;
- I need to send my child to school in clean clothes each day where possible;
- **All children** will need to be dropped off by a responsible person; this could be an older sibling who will stay with them until they enter the school building. **All children** must be collected by a responsible person;
- If my child, shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately (or if advised to by the local health team);
- When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will adhere to the 2-metre social distancing rules and will only drop them at the allocated gate.
- My child must not bring any items into school with them (except a water bottle and PE kit) or take items home from school (except a water bottle and PE kit);
- My child will have their temperature taken on arrival and during the day if they present as being unwell. A member of SLT will be consulted and my child **may** then be sent home if it is raised (red).
- I will need to remind my child about social distancing rules
- My child will need to wash their hands for 20 seconds with soap and sneeze/cough into their elbow or a tissue.
- I will not be allowed into the school unless this has been arranged with the Head Teacher;
- I must read all letters and messages that are sent home;
- I must inform the school immediately of any changes to any contacts details;
- If my child cannot behave safely, they will be sent home and cannot return to school until they can be safe.

- Go straight home and stay 2 metres apart from others;

- Follow these instructions and know that if I cannot, I will be sent home and will not be able to come back into school until I can be safe.
