

Parent Voice Meeting

Date: 21st July 2026

1. Vision and Values

- Parents detailed the vision and values of Moorside.
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2. Reflection on this year

- Positive reflection on the year, including the success of Moorside Magic, trips and improved homework consistency.
 - SATs results were the school's best ever (66% combined), with outcomes above national averages. Times Tables Check average was 22/25, with over half achieving full marks.
 - Summer Fair raised £1,100 and the Book Fair raised £900.
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3. Updates

- Updates shared on wraparound care, £2 charge for after-school clubs, behaviour policy changes and new curriculum overviews.
 - Discussion around improving GLD outcomes and better spacing of school events and fundraising requests.
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4. Parent Feedback

- Residential trip was highly praised, with a suggestion for clearer communication about updates and phone signal limitations.
- Views from parents about this year- homework is better this year- more consistent, view it as a positive year.
- Parents thanked staff for their hard work, excellent SATs results and the success of Parent Voice.
- Concerns about Year 6 pupils using the vehicle gate were addressed; the school explained safety measures were in place and it was an exceptional circumstance due to the coach parking over the entrance.
- Request for support with secondary school applications and admissions portal; school to explore providing guidance for next year.
- Parents suggested colour-coding updated calendars
