Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope this finds you well. I am writing to you as I received an update letter on Friday evening from the Director of Population Health, Dr Jeanelle de Gruchy which has been uploaded to Dojo and the website. She has recommended that schools prepare for wider re-opening from the 22nd June. We have remained opened for children of key workers throughout and will continue to do so.

As previously stated, we will begin wider re-opening using the same plans which were put in place previously including the phased returns of year groups and staggered starts and finish times. Last week I wrote to you to ask that you inform us **by the end of today** if you had changed your mind about whether your child is attending. This is particularly important if you have previously said no but would now like your child to attend. This is because we will plan and prepare on the basis of the previous number of children we were expecting. If at any time going forward, you change your mind from a no to a yes then you must give at school **five working days notice** and have your child's attendance confirmed before sending them in. This is to ensure that we have space in bubbles and can prepare individualised learning packs.

Parents and carers who have previously indicated that they would be sending their child/children in will be resent the previous details and new start date for their child's year group shortly. Please read and follow the instructions carefully in order to keep everyone as safe as possible.

We are looking forward to welcoming some of our children back to school.
