KS1 SATs / KS2 SATs Week: We understand these to be week commencing Monday 11th May 2026.

Phonics Screening for Year 1 & Year 2 takes place from the Monday 8 June 2026.

Multiplication tables check for Year 4 takes place within the 2-week period from Monday 1st June 2026.

It is very important that all children attend school during these periods of times.

DfE Guidelines mean that **NO** holiday requests will be authorised by school unless there are extremely special circumstances. When a pupil has at least 10 sessions of unauthorised absences from school, we have to notify the Local Authority and this may result in the issuing of a Penalty Notice fine of £80.00 per child, per parent.
