



Dear Parent/Guardian

We are very excited to announce that we are organising a three day residential trip at the Kingswood Centre, Colomendy, in October 2025. We are very fortunate to have secured a booking as it is an extremely popular venue with school groups.

For parents who are new to Kingswood, they are a leading residential activity centre provider, responsible for delivering safe and rewarding educational programmes to over 170,000 children every year. By combining many National Curriculum-linked modules with thrilling outdoor and indoor adventure activities, this trip is sure to provide your child with a wealth of new experiences outside of the classroom while developing key learning outcomes.

Residential courses organised by the school are, of course, an optional but invaluable part of the National Curriculum. Pupils benefit hugely from the experience, both educationally and socially and I feel certain that the Adventure Choice programme which we have chosen this year will prove to be both enjoyable and very worthwhile.

We would like to offer this opportunity to the pupils from the present Year **5**. The trip will take place from **Monday 6<sup>th</sup> October** to **Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> October**. The cost of the visit will be **£210.00** and includes return travel by coach, full board, accommodation and a full programme of activities. To confirm our booking, an initial non-refundable deposit of **£100.00** will be required **by Monday 31<sup>st</sup> March 2025 via MCAS**. Payment of the deposit and consent online is an acceptance of the booking conditions.

The payment for this is staggered across the academic year according to the schedule below. It is essential that this schedule is adhered to as we don't want to have to chase parents for money.

# **BOOKING CONDITIONS**

1) All payments for school trips and resources are made via MCAS. Please pay online by logging into your account or ask the Office about paying cash via PayPoint outlets. (Be aware that if any money, if refunded, goes into your PayPoint account and can not be returned to a bank account). The school no longer accepts cash or cheques for school trips or resources but are happy to help you with any MCAS queries or problems.

2) All deposits are non-refundable even if your child leaves the School.

3)If we are unable to fill enough spaces (minimum number not yet confirmed), there is a possibility the trip will have to be cancelled.

3) To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all students, children will only be allowed to participate if they have an excellent behavioural record. The school reserves the right to remove, from this trip at any stage, any student whose behaviour becomes a concern. Should this happen the school may not refund installments nor refund the deposit.

4) You must inform the school of any changes to your child's medical and dietary needs and/or emergency contact details.

5) The school must be made aware of any medical reason why the child may not travel and, if requested to, provide confirmation of not being fit to travel by a medical practitioner. Then a refund maybe possible.
