Absences

We have sought advice from the relevant authorities who have asked us to ensure children are following the advice of:

- Regularly washing their hands with soap and water
- Catching sneezes and coughs in a tissue and throwing them in a bin

You will see from the class attendances on the reverse how much it has affected the school. Hopefully we have turned a corner and things should start to improve.
