If you have not collected your letter regarding setting up your child's MCAS account, please can you collect from the office or call the office as soon as possible? You must activate your child's 'My Child at School' account as soon as possible so that you can access their school meals, breakfast club, trips and attendance when we return after half term. Any outstanding debts on your parent pay account must be cleared by Friday noon. All outstanding credits and debits will be transferred on Friday afternoon. Debts on accounts could stop you from consenting/paying for any school trips or activities.
