Dear parents/Carers,

As a school we are looking at how we can improve digital learning for our children to align more with 'real life'. With this in mind, we have decided that we would like the children (and your support may be needed) to become more confident when using the Microsoft Teams platform.

Microsoft Teams has a wealth of programmes which will improve children's understanding in the digital world. Through the Computing curriculum, children will be taught how to use the different programmes and how to navigate the software.

We are also planning to use the Teams platform to send some homework for children. In order for them to access Teams from home they will need a log in (their full email address) and a password.

Over the next few days teachers will send their email address and password individually for each child through Dojo message – please look out for it.

Next week some homework will be sent through Teams and children should access this at home. All children from Year 1 to 6 will be shown in school how to access and complete work on there.

We appreciate there may be some initial teething problems. In the first instance, please let the class teacher know by sending a message on Dojo if you are experiencing any access problems and they will try to support you to gain access.

Thank you for your support with this, especially with the younger children who are likely to need your help to access their work.
