

Food banks in Tameside

We know that anyone can find themselves at crisis point for a number of different reasons.

In order to provide the most appropriate help for the circumstances of your situation food banks work with local agencies. If you feel you are struggling to put food on the table, you can be issued with a food bank voucher or can independently collect an emergency parcel. Some of the local agencies that can issue food bank vouchers include School agencies, Health Visitors, some G.P surgeries, New Charter Hubs (for NC residents) Ashton Pioneer Homes (For APH residents), Citizens Advice Bureau, Tameside MBC Customer Services. Some local agencies can also provide long term support if needed to help address some of the issues behind the reasons for your crisis. When you visit a referral agency for a food bank voucher they will take some basic details from you to complete the voucher. This will help them to identify the cause of your crisis and offer practical guidance. It also means they are able to prepare suitable emergency food for the right number of people. Once you have been issued with a voucher, you can exchange this for a minimum of three days of emergency food at your nearest food bank centre.
