Attendance

Regular attenders make better progress, both socially and academically. Regular attenders find school routines, school work and friendships easier to cope with. It is important children are on time and come through their own door rather than arrive late and go through the office. The autumn term is a crucial time to establish good routines so if we can help you in anyway to ensure your child is in school, please let us know. Mrs Hardy and Mrs Grace will support you and your child if they have any worries.

Reminder: Penalty Notice Fines will be issued for term time leave of 5 or more consecutive days. A Penalty Notice may be considered/issued when a pupil has had 10 sessions of unauthorised absence in a 10-week period.

School Meals

Please encourage your children to try school meals. Universal free meals – Free school meals are for all pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 provided by the Government. We are having a 'Character Favourites Day' on Thursday 3rd October. Please see Dojo for the menu.

Jewellery

Firstly, please note pupils should only wear studs, not hoops. We are not able to remove children's stud earrings. Ideally, they should not wear earrings on PE days. If they do wear them, they must be able to remove them for themselves. We can no longer put tape over them. If they have just had them pierced, they may have tape over them for the first 6 weeks. This must be done at home.

PE Kit

Reminder: please ensure that your child comes to school in the <u>correct PE kit</u> on their PE days, including appropriate footwear <u>(no football kits or t-shirts with slogans or different coloured clothing)</u>. Their games session with Mr Stringfellow will be outside, even as it gets colder, so please ensure they have track suits/jogging bottoms and

sweatshirts. For health and safety regulations, your child must have the correct footwear, or will not be able to participate. We look forward to welcoming you into school soon!
