Physical Education

This term we will be focusing on dance and sending and receiving balls. The children will be throwing and catching balls as well as developing their kicking skills. For dance the children will be counting in steps of 8 and using facial expressions to enhance

PSHE

In PSHE this term we will look at dreams and goals. This term our value is Gratitude. We will learn about differences. We will learn why it is important to respects others and their differences.

Mathematics

This term in Maths we will be partitioning numbers to 20 and learning the addition and subtraction facts for numbers 11-20. We will continue to practise our reasoning and problemsolving skills. The children will explore counting forwards and backwards to 100 as well as in 10s, 5s and 2s

Design Technology

This term in DT we will be exploring mechanisms. We will look at how to make pictures using lift the flaps, slides, levers and pop ups.

Computing

This term in Computing we will learn about how to control a physical device. The children will be using Beebots to execute a set of instructions using directional language.

English

This term our learning will be based upon the books Poles Apart and Dear Greenpeace. We will be continuing to write in a sequence of sentences and developing skills of ioning sentences together using and.


