Computing

This term in Computing we will be exploring how we can create music in the digital world. The children will be using google music player to create their own rhythms as well as listening to other children's creations.

<u>Science</u>

This term in Science we will be looking at the weather and the different types of weather we might see in each season. We will be thinking about the different signs of each season too.

<u>Art</u>

This term in Art we will be looking at the artist Njideka Akunyili. Children will explore the techniques of using mixed materials to create texture. The children will be creating a scene using mixed media based on the work of Njideka Akunyili.

<u>Mathematics</u>

This term is Maths we will be looking at strategies to help with recalling addition and subtraction sums up to 20. We will be doubling and halving numbers too. They will be counting in 2s 5s and 10s and linking these to multiplication and division.

Physical Education

This term in PE we are continuing with gymnastics. We will also be focussing on athletics. The children will be practising how to sprint and how to run for longer distances. Towards the end of the term, the children will be practising for their sports day events.

<u>English</u>

This term we will be looking at the books 'Lost in the toy museum' and 'Tidy'. We will be learning to use the suffix est to compare things and recap using the suffix ed. The children are continuing to develop their independent writing and beginning to edit the work they have written. We will be retelling the story of the 'Lost in the toy museum'. And we will be writing instructions linked to the book 'Tidy'.

Religious Education

We will find out about Islam. Our terms R.E question is Does going to the Mosque give Muslims a sense of belonging?

PSHE

In PSHE this term we explore relationships. We will be discovering how families come in different shapes and sizes. We will discuss the importance of identifying conflict and how to resolve that.

<u>Music</u>

In Music the children will be exploring live and recorded music. They will use different instruments to create a range of rhythm, tempos and pitches.
