

Computing

This term in Computing we are learning about Information Technology. We will be looking at graphs and pictograms. Interpreting and representing data in pictogram form. The children will begin to understand what the term data means and how data can be collected in the form of a tally chart.

Physical Education

This term the children will be learning gymnastic skills inside. The children will also be learning the skills needed to play invasion games such as running on the balls of your feet and using your periphery vision.

English

This term our focus books are 'Beegu' and 'Paddington'. We will be retelling the stories and innovating our own endings. We will applying different skills including suffix ed, question marks and linking sentences together. The children will continue to develop their independence in writing too.

Science

This term in Science we will be finding out about materials and their properties. We will be able to compare the suitability of materials for different purposes and complete simple tests.

Mathematics

This term in Maths we will be looking at addition and subtraction facts of numbers 17-20. We will look at fractions and find $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{1}{4}$ of a shape and number. We will be continuing to develop our knowledge and understanding place value of numbers up to 100.

Geography

This term in Geography we will be learning about our local area. We will be looking at a variety of maps and using directional vocabulary to reach different locations. We will also draw our own maps and plans from our local area.

Music

Children will be composing music linked to the story of 'Little Red'. They will be looking at the pitch, tempo and rhythm of different music.
