English

Throughout Term 6, we will be refining and mastering our writing skills by writing different texts around World War 2. Having already learnt plenty about this in Term 5, we will now be writing newspaper reports and formal war speeches to apply our learning from throughout the year.

In Guided Reading, we will continue studying, 'The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas' and delving into the differences in the times, beliefs and prejudices present in the book.

Art

In Art we will be creating WW2 pieces using foam boards and ink for printing. We will look into layering colour and perfecting our imprints to create an effective look.

DT

For DT, we will be using our electrical knowledge to adapt model aircraft by placing lights onto the wings. We will also be looking at how to safely store food and using this, will create own rations menu that would have been suitable in WW2. Both will be finalised with an evaluation

Physical Development

This term, the children we learning how to play rounders and volleyball. They will also refine their athletic skills in preparation for Sports Day.

Music

In Music this term, Year 6 will be preparing their songs for the KS2 Music Extravaganza show in June.

Maths

In Maths this term, we will also be mastering and refining our learning from the past year.
