PHSE:

Make a family tree showing who is in your family, including grandparents. How far can you go back?

Maths:

Write your own word problems for the times table you are currently learning. (Year 3 - 3, 4 & 8; Year 4 - 6, 7 & 9) Can you create any problems that need multiple steps to answer?
