Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back! We hope you have had a restful half term break and are ready to start the new term! This term, our school theme is Give, focusing on the values generosity, kindness and gratitude. It is also worth putting some spare underwear/socks in your child's PE bag.

Please can you provide your child with a clearly named plastic water bottle to use throughout the day. The children can refill their bottles from the tap in the classroom. Your child will also have a carton of milk to drink in the morning. This can be ordered via the website 'Cool Milk.' Your child is entitled to receive a free carton of milk if they are under 5. If your child is over 5 then you will need to order and pay for this on the 'Cool Milk' website.

Please continue to listen to your child read regularly, practice their letter formation (Reception) and encourage them to practise their spellings (Year 1). This term they are based on their phonic lessons, so contain new graphemes they have learnt.

Attendance is a high priority at Moredon. Please support us with this by making sure that your children are in school every day and on time.
