Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back! We hope you had a restful half term break and are ready to start the final summer term! This term, Reception will be learning about superheroes and the seaside. We will be reading 'Supertato' books by Sue Hendra and Paul Linnet and 'What the Ladybird heard at the Seaside' by Julia Donaldson as well as other Summer themed books and poems. Our Value this Term is *Respect*.

<u>Trip</u>

A reminder that we will be going to Cotswold Wildlife Park on Tuesday 18th June. This is to be paid via ParentPay, if not done so already. We will give more details on Dojo nearer the time.

<u>PE</u>

We are continuing to do PE on Friday's for both RSSM and RBP classes. Please remember our PE rules which are as follows-

*long hair is tied back.

*earrings covered or taken out.

We will continue to ask the children to change into P.E kits in school, so please send in a **<u>clearly named</u>** P.E kit as soon as possible.

This should include –

- * a white t-shirt
- * black shorts

* daps/trainers

* socks and spare underwear

It is worth putting in a pair of plain dark tracksuit bottoms and a jumper as the weather can still be cold and we will be outside for our PE lessons. Please can you also check that your child's PE kit especially their daps/trainers fit them properly and that everyting is named.

Our theme this term is Games, and we will be focusing on learning how to build our strength, agility and coordination through running, jumping and throwing. We will be learning how to work co-operatively and follow rules with a partner and as part of a team.

<u>Water bottles</u>

Please can you provide your child with a clearly named plastic water bottle to use throughout the day. The children can refill their bottles from the tap in the classroom. We will also provide your child with a mid-morning snack of fresh fruit. If you have signed up to Cool Milk then your child will also have a carton of milk to drink in the morning unless they are already 5.

Please make time for your child to read this book with you and return this on the Monday morning.

We will continue to send phonics related homework in your child's homework book. Please return on Thursday's so we can send new homework out each Friday. Please encourage your child to complete it as independently as possible.
