### **Science: Plants**

### **Art: Pointillism**

Cotton Bud Trees: Paint a colorful tree using only tiny dots made with a cotton bud.

Primary Dot Mix: Place red and yellow dots close together to create a bright orange.

### **Computing: Digital Writing**

Emoji Pirate Story: Type a short pirate story on Purple Mash using fun, colorful digital emojis.

Font Style Challenge: Practice typing your name using five different sizes, colors, and cool fonts.

### **Value: Keep Active**

Daily Minute Challenge: Count how many star jumps you can do in sixty seconds every morning.

Alphabet Scavenger Hunt: Run to find objects starting with every letter in the word "active" quickly.
