Our value this term is connect. Create a "Connection Chain": Write or draw five ways you connect with friends or family (in person or online). Link them together like a paper chain. Design a "Connect App": Draw an app icon and explain how your app helps people connect safely using SMART rules.

- Our topic is based on The great fire of London. Write a postcard to someone telling them all about what you experienced as the baker in the great fire of London. Create a News Report: Pretend you are a reporter in 1666. Write or record a short news report about the fire.
- In Computing, we are looking at algorithms. Load Purple Mash and play the 2go game in the computing section giving instructions for the onscreen Beebot to follow. If you would like to play other algorithm games then go into the computing section for more algorithm games. Create a Maze Challenge: Draw a maze and write an algorithm for a friend to follow to get to the end.
- In Science, we are learning about materials. Create a poster of the materials in your kitchen and why the appliances are made out of that material. Waterproof Test: Test 3 materials to see which are waterproof. Record your results in a table.
- Make a house from the great fire of London out of sticks, leaves and other garden items.
- Create your own artwork of a fiery skyline using paint, collage, or digital art.
