Accepting a school place

You have now had your offer of a school place, whether you have chosen Moredon or a different school. Please ensure you accept your school place so that your child's place can be secured. If you have chosen to send your child to Moredon, you will shortly receive a letter inviting you to attend our Reception induction evening in June where you will be given your induction pack and lots of information regarding school transition and starting school.

<u>Reading</u>

Reading continues to be a priority and we do expect the children to share their books regularly at home. Remember to fill in the reading record with ANY book read at home (including own books, library books



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and school books) as once your child has read 50 times, 100 times and 150 times, there are prizes to be won! Your child has the opportunity to change their book daily. I check all the yellow reading records daily and when I see your child has read the book in their bookbag, your child then takes it out and chooses a new one.

<u>Class Dojo</u>

Please upload photos to your child's ClassDojo portfolio regularly. We share our news as often as possible and the children love to have their news read out, adding their own information too. Thank you to those that have shared pictures on Dojo. A weekly/fortnightly update about your weekends and/or new achievements are great to share. If you are not sure how to upload, please message me on Dojo or come and speak to me, but to start, you need to be on your child's account. I leave all uploads as pending and then approve them as I share them with the class. This helps me to keep track of whose news I have shared and whose I haven't so please don't worry if it says your photos are pending approval for a little while!

Just a few reminders...

- Please ensure all uniform is named and please ensure bottles are renamed too when names are washed off.
- Any more snack contributions are to be paid through ParentPay.

As the weather gets warmer, please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for school. Bring in a named sun hat and please put sun cream on your child before they come to Nursery as they are outside during every session. Your child can then apply top ups if needed, under the direction of staff. Please ensure water bottles are brought into school as I am sure they will be drinking more.
