

English:

The book, 'Wisp' will be used as a focus for our writing this term. Writing skills will include setting and character descriptions and fronted adverbials for time, place and manner.

PE:

For PE this term, we will be learning how to play dodgeball and to improve their athletic skills. In dodgeball, they will learn how to throw accurately at a target and be ready to defend themselves during games.

Science:

For Science, we will be learning about living things. We will look at different characteristics of living things and use this to help group and classify them. The children will also explore what living things they can find in their local habitat, as well as other habitats.

Geography:

For Geography this term, we will be exploring different features of physical geography. We will look at what the water cycle is as well as learning how the earth is made from tectonic plates.

PHSE:

This term in PSHE our topic will be 'Relationships'. We will understand roles, responsibilities and expectations for family members, understand how to remain safe online, recognise the work of others around the world and its impact.

Maths:

Year 3 children will be learning how to find fractions of numbers. They will also look at time, including telling time to the nearest minute. Year 4 children will be adding and subtracting fractions and furthering their knowledge of angles.

Music:

This term we are learning some new songs and practicing their recorder skills ready for the Music Extravaganza in Term 6.

RE:

For RE this term, we are exploring the best ways for Jews to show their commitment to God. We will be looking at Bar Mitzvahs and Bat Mitzvahs and their importance to Jewish people.

French:

In French, we will learn how to write and say different types of food.

Art:

For Art this term, we will be exploring Kay and Kim Vaudin who are two artists that paint different underwater scenes. We will look at how to create a piece of work inspired by the colourful artwork they produce.

DT:

In DT this term, we are learning how to join textiles using appropriate stitching techniques. We will explore different materials and methods of stitching by creating our own nautical creature.

Computing:

This term we are using software to edit images. We will be discussing the ethics around editing images and understanding where it is appropriate to do so. We will use layering, cropping and other features to change images.
