

English:

In English, the children will be exploring The Barnabus Project, a story about an unusual creature and their desire to be free. Children will use expanded noun phrases and character descriptions in their writing.

PE:

For PE this term, children will be doing Fitness and Ball skills. They will take part in a range of activities that explore and develop their health and fitness. The children will also have opportunities to develop a variety of ball skills without the restrictions of games and rules.

Science:

For Science this term, the children will be exploring the parts and functions of the digestive system and teeth. They will be doing an experiment using eggs to show that enamel can be damaged. The children will also watch a demonstration of the digestive system using food and drink.

Music:

The children are going to continue with learning the recorder this term. They will learn new notes to play and begin to use these when playing songs.

PHSE:

This term in PSHE our topic will be 'Celebrating Differences'. The children will look at how we are all different from each other and how people may have stereotypical views. They will also explore what bullying is and how they can put a stop to it.

Maths:

In Year 3, the children will be learning the 3x, 4x and 8x table. In Year 4, the children will be learning the 6x, 9x and 7x tables. They will also learn what happens when multiplying by zero. All children will also learn mental strategies for addition and subtraction.

Art:

For Art this term, the children are going to be developing their drawing skills. They are going to look at how to sketch a landscape and add tone and texture to a piece of work using only pencil.

French:

In French, the children will be able to say and write French words for items of clothing. They will also be able to compose a sentence in French using j'aime or je n'aime pas.

DT:

For DT this term, the children are going to use their Scientific knowledge of forces to choose appropriate mechanisms for a product. This will link to the use of levers and pulleys during the construction of Egyptian pyramids.

RE:

For RE this term, the children will be looking at the significance of the Christmas story to Christians. They will explore the question, 'What is the most significant part of the nativity story for Christians today?'

Computing:

In Computing this term, the children are going to be creating media with a focus on audio production. They will be using websites such as Audacity to have a go at creating, recording and editing sounds. Towards the end of the term, the children will also be thinking about podcasts in their learning and how these can be created.

History:

In History, the children will be learning about the Egyptians. They will look at what life was like back in Ancient Egyptian times, including how they used hieroglyphics. They will also look at some key figures during this time and how Egyptians celebrated and worshipped these figures. In addition, the children will learn about the discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb.
