

Music

For Music this term the children will be carrying on with their ukulele lessons. The children will also spend time practising the singing of the songs for the Easter production.

PE

For indoor PE, children will be doing dance. They will learn how to do different movements and how to place them into a routine to music.

For outdoor PE, children will be learning about football. They will combine various skills in order to play a game.

Science

The children will learn about plants. They will look at the different parts of a plant and why plants have these parts. They will also look at what a plant needs to survive, including how water is transported through the plant. They will look at how flowers play an important part in the life cycle of a plant.

Geography

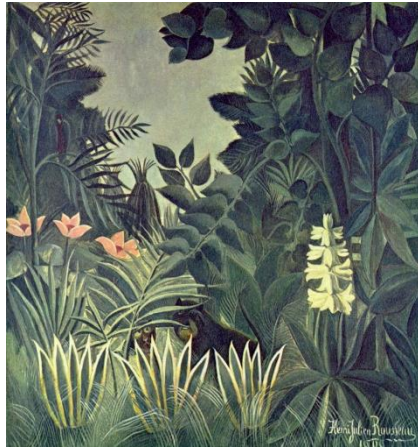
In Geography, the children will be learning the difference between human and physical features. They will use real and digital maps to locate countries and also to describe the human and physical features of those countries.

PHSE

The children will be looking at being fit and healthy this term, including the importance of exercise and exploring what a balanced diet looks like. They will also look into their mental wellbeing and things that make them feel safe or unsafe.

French:

The children will begin to explore some of the grammatical terms used in French. They will also investigate the French term 'Joyeuses Paques' which equates to 'Happy Easter'.

DT

In DT this term, the children will be creating their own bird feeders using natural resources. Children will select an appropriate cutting tool to cut their resources and then assemble everything together.

English

In English, children will be studying the book 'Fly Eagle Fly'. They will revisit previous skills, including paragraphs, inverted commas and exclamation marks. In Reading, children will be studying the book 'The Sheep Pig.' They will continue developing fluency using the Reader's Theatre approach.

Maths

In Maths this term, the children will begin by refining their multiplication and division skills. They will learn how to multiply using the distributive law. This will be followed by doing calculations which involve money.

Computing

In Computing, the children will be exploring what branching databases are. After exploring how these work, children will then have a go at creating their own branching database.

RE

In RE this term, the children will be exploring the key question, 'What is good about Good Friday?' Through the understanding of the Easter story, they will explore their own views about Jesus' miracles and resurrection.
