English:

In our Writing lessons, the children will explore the BFG. They will write some character descriptions and continue practising using speech.

In Reading lessons, the children will be exploring Stig of the Dump. They will continue to develop their fluency and comprehension.

PE:

The outdoor PE topic this term is Athletics where the children will develop basic running, jumping and throwing techniques. The indoor PE topic this term is Fitness. The children will take part in a range of activities that explore and develop different areas of their health and fitness.

Science:

In Science this term, the children will continue learning about plants. They will learn about the different parts of a flower. They will also look at the different sections of the life cycle of a flower. Children will do a number of practical experiments about their learning.

History:

This term, the children will be studying the Stone Age. They will look at how they started out as Hunter Gatherers and then how they developed farming.

PHSE:

Learning about relationships is the PSHE focus for the children this term. This will include exploring the different relationships that people have within a family.

French:

This term, in French, the children will learn how to pronounce and write French words linked to animals and colours. They will also learn the French song, 'Le fermier dans son pre'.

<u>Music:</u>

The children will continue to learn how to play the ukulele. They will start their preparations for their ukulele performances in the Music Festival in Term 6.

Maths:

The children will learn how to find fractions of numbers and how to add and subtract fractions. They will also learn how to read clocks to the nearest minute. Children will also learn how many seconds there are in a minute, minutes in an hour and the number of days in each month.

Computing:

In Computing this term, the children will become familiar with the terms 'text' and 'images' and understand that they can be used to communicate messages. They will use desktop publishing software to create their own magazine front cover.

RE:

The children will be exploring the key question, 'How can Brahman be everywhere and in everything?' The children will be learning to understand the Hindu belief that there is one God with many different aspects.

DT:

The children will explore different prehistoric pots and then design their own pot.

They will then use different techniques to create a pot out of clay.
