

English:

The book focus for English this term is Hortense and the Shadow. The children will be writing a prequel of the story and skills that children will learn this term include the use of the past perfect tense, inverted commas for speech and the description of characters and settings.

PE:

The two sports for PE in Term 6 are rounders and tennis. Skills will include throwing, catching and striking in rounders and using basic racket skills in tennis.

Art:

In Art this term, children will explore the work created by William Morris. They will learn how to make their own printing block to make prints.

Science:

In Science this term, the children will be learning all about light. This will include knowing the various sources of light, learning about the terms 'opaque', 'translucent' and 'transparent' and what reflections are. The children will also be aware of the importance of sun safety.

History:

In History, the children will be learning about the Victorians. They will look at key dates that happened during this period and how the Victorians lived. They will also have a Victorian experience day and explore what a Victorian school day used to be like.

French:

In French, the children will learn the names for different animals and colours and they will begin to look at expressing opinions in French.

PHSE:

This term in PSHE the topic will be 'Changing Me'. The children will be looking at the changes that happen to the body. They will also look at what happens to babies when they are still inside the mother's body and how they grow.

Music:

When singing, the children will think about harmonies and pitch as they rehearse for their performance at the Music Concert. They will also perform their ukulele playing at the concert.

DT:

In DT this term, the children will understand and apply the principles of a healthy and varied diet. This will lead to them using cooking techniques to make shortbread.

Maths:

Measurement, Geometry and Statistics are the three main topics in Maths this term. The children will be learning more about angles, turns, pictograms, bar charts, measuring using a ruler and finding the mass of objects.

Computing:

In Computing this term, the children will explore the links between events and actions, whilst consolidating prior learning relating to sequencing. This will include the design of a sprite which will move within a maze.

RE:

The RE theme for this term is 'Pilgrimage to the River Ganges' and the children will be exploring the key question, 'Would visiting the River Ganges feel special to a non-Hindu?'
