

### English:

In English this term, we will be reading *Varmints* by Helen Ward. We will be exploring present perfect tense, apostrophes for plural possession and fronted adverbials for manner.

### Maths:

For Maths, we will explore the 11 and 12 times table and learn the multiplication facts and division facts for each of these tables. We will also look at how to use written methods for addition and subtraction.

### French:

In French, we are going to be learning how to describe our hair, eyes and different body parts. We will also be revisiting adjectives such as colours.

### PE:

For PE this term, we are doing hockey and dance. Hockey will be with our sports coach Kieran supporting us and we will look at how to dribble, pass and score goals.

### Science:

For Science this term, we will be exploring food chains. We will be learning about how certain animals adapt in their habitats and how these fit into the food chain. We will then be creating a fact file at the end of the topic to summarise what we have learnt.

### Geography:

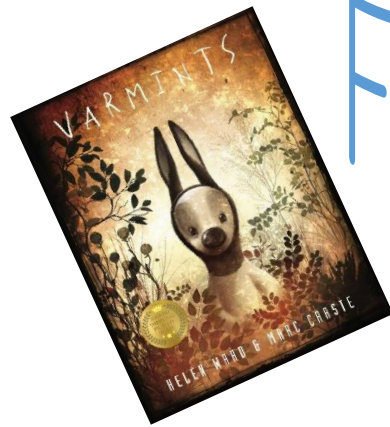
