English:

English this term will be based on the book The Lost Happy Endings by Carol Ann Duffy. Children will recap and practice punctuation speech as well as developing character and setting descriptions.

PE:

Dance and football are the two PE topics for this term. In dance, we will learn and create dance moves using the theme of carnival. Football skills will include dribbling, changing direction, passing, attacking and defending.

Science:

For Science this term, we will be looking at states of matter. We will learn the differences between gases, liquids and solids. We will also be looking at what happens to the particles when states of matter change.

PHSE:

This term in PSHE our topic will be 'healthy me'. We will look at our friendship groups, what peer pressure means and how this can impact us. We will also look at ways in which we can keep our bodies healthy.

Art:

For Art this term, we are going to be making some printing patterns. We will look at how to make a printing block using rope and cardboard. We will then use this printing block to make a repeated pattern and a rotated pattern.

Maths:

For Maths, we will be exploring how to multiply and divde 3-digit numbers by a 1-digit number. This will be done through the use of written methods. Towards the end of the term, we will be learning about angles, including acute and obtuse.
