# English

The book, Wolves in the Wall, will be explored by the children this term. The children will be rewriting parts of the story using English skills such as fronted adverbials for place and manner and direct speech.

### PE:

Our indoor PE focus for this term is gymnastics and the outdoor focus is hockey. Skills learnt will include balances and rolls in gymnastics and passing, intercepting and shooting in hockey.

In history, we will explore

## PHSE:

This term in PSHE, our topic will be 'Dreams and Goals'. We will be learning to accept feelings of hurt when hopes don't come true, using reflection of positive experiences to overcome disappointment, identifying next steps and new plans.

### Maths:

For Maths, we will explore the II and 12 times table and learn the multiplication facts and division facts for each of these tables. We will also look at how to use written methods for addition and subtraction.

Spring Term 1 2025 DT:

RF:

In DT this term, we will be using recipes from World War Two to create our own meal. We will explore rationing and learn why it was vital to the war effort.

### French:

In French, we are going to be learning how to describe our hair, eyes and different body parts. We will also be revisiting adjectives such as colours.

# Computing:
