English:

Throughout Term 2, we will be reading the text 'The Phone Booth in Mr Hirota's Garden'. We will begin by writing to entertain; re-telling the story using passive voice for empathy and cohesion. We will also focus on writing to persuade; using a range of techniques to change the mind of a target audience.

Maths:

We will begin the term with formal multiplication and division methods.
We will then begin the topic of Fractions; understanding them and then moving onto comparing and ordering them. We will use concrete resources and visual aids to help us understand how Fractions create a whole.

French:

In French, we are going to be learning how to say what clothes we are wearing. We will continue to develop our confidence in speaking to others.

Art:

For Art this term, we are going to be creating collages using a range of different techniques. We will look at how to create effects which will reflect the themes of the book, 'The Phone Booth in Mr Hirota's Garden'

PE:

For PE this term, we will be learning how to play tennis and dodgeball. We will be applying previously learnt skills in both of these sports.

Science:

This term we will be learning all about Electricity. We will explore how to make different circuits using key components. We will learn how to evaluate a circuit; assessing whether or not it will operate. We will investigate how to debug and correct a circuit.

Geography:

For Geography, we are going to be comparing a location in Europe and a location in South America.

We will be comparing Paris and Rio De Janeiro, looking into the difference in cultures, weather, food and traditions.

PHSE:

This term in PSHE our topic will be 'Celebrating Differences'. We will look at how we are all different from each other and how people can cope with bullying. We will delve into the issue of Power and how some people can use power to make others feel bad.
