Welcome to back for Term 4. We hope you had a lovely half-term break- it already feels like a life-time ago!

Our topic for this term is 'The Greeks'. For English, we will be using the text 'The Man Who Walked Between the Towers' to inspire our narrative and non-fiction writing. We have lots of exciting things planned for this term including some food tasting and a Greek dress up day on Wednesday 27th March 2024. A reminder to please let us know if your children have any allergies in advance.

As before, children are expected to read their banded books every night to ensure they keep up their fluency and understanding. We will give pupils a new book to read once they have finished the one, they are currently reading. They should also practise their spellings which will be posted weekly on Class Dojo and practise their times tables daily. We will be continuing to send home weekly homework for Reading, Grammar and Maths which is due in every Tuesday.

Both classes continue to have PE on a Monday and Tuesday. Please make sure that children have a full PE kit in school in line with our PE kit policy (white top, black short/joggers, and a black jumper). Monday's PE lesson will be outside so a jumper may be necessary as the temperature continues to be chilly. A reminder that jewellery must be removed for PE and long hair must be tied back.

Please make sure that your children come to school with a healthy snack and water bottle every day.
