Welcome to back for Term 5. We hope you had a lovely Easter break!

A reminder that doors will be open from 8.30am, with the register being taken promptly at 8:35am. After 8:45am, your child is marked as late. Pick up time is at 3.30pm and 1.30pm on Fridays.

Please can we give a gentle reminder about uniform expectations. Children should be wearing a white shirt, black jumper/cardigan (not a zip up hoodie), black trousers/skirt/shorts, school tie and all black shoes. It does not have to have the Moredon school badge on clothing, but we do expect the children to look smart and presentable and wear the correct school uniform. We appreciate times might be tough for some families and we will try to support you where possible with uniform.

This term in English, we will be using the text 'Letters from the Lighthouse' by Emma Carroll to inspire our writing. We also have a huge unit on fractions this term in maths. Clarinets will be continuing to alternate every other Wednesday for each Year 5 class.

As before, children are expected to read their banded books every night to ensure they keep up their fluency and understanding. We will give pupils a new book to read once they have finished the book they are currently reading. They should also practise their spellings which are posted weekly on Spelling Shed and practise their times tables daily. We will be continuing to send home weekly homework for Reading, Grammar and Maths which is due in every Friday.

Both classes continue to have PE on a Monday and Wednesday. Please make sure that children have a full PE kit in school in line with our PE kit policy (white top, black short/joggers, and a black jumper). Monday's PE lesson will be outside so a jumper may be necessary. A reminder that jewellery must be removed for PE and long hair must be tied back.
