

Computing

This term in Computing we will be using scratch junior to write and create their own code, The children will be creating their own quizzes using this code. They will be planning and creating their own design.

Physical Education

This term in PE our topic is striking and fielding. The children will be learning about controlling a ball. They will also be learning Netball, in which they will learn the different types of throwing and shooting.

English

This term we will be focusing on the book 'We're Going on a Lion Hunt' by David Axtell and looking at other books such as 'Handa's Surprise' and 'Old Mikamba Had a Farm'. Following this, we will read 'Betsy Buglove Saves the Bees' by Catherine Jacob and look at non-fiction books such as 'Why do we need bees?'

We will continue to develop our sentence writing skills, using adjectives and connectives such as 'and'. We will use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. In Grammar we will be reviewing all Year 1 objectives covered over the year.

Mathematics

This term in Maths we will be looking at direction, using language to describe direction. We will be spending the remainder of the term consolidating our learning by covering all of the Year 1 objectives.

Religious Education

This term in RE we are exploring Special Places. We will be learning how churches, mosques and synagogues are special. Our value this term is resilience and we will be exploring how we can show resilience in our learning.

Science

For DT this term the children will be making bread. The children will understand the different types of bread and the ingredients that go into them.

Year One children will learn how to play different rhythms and create different sounds. We will also be creating our own music and performing in our Musical Extravaganza in July.

History

This term in History we will be finding out about the lives of Neil Armstrong and Sir Tim Peake. We will use the Internet to research their lives and find out what it is like in space,
