

Computing

This term in Computing, we will be exploring Digital Writing. We will begin by looking at the keyboard, then move on to how to use Shift, Caps Lock, and numbers, as well as how to select and edit text. We will also practise these skills through simple tasks to help build confidence and accuracy when typing.

Physical Education

This term in PE, we will be continuing with gymnastics and will also be focusing on athletics. The children will practise how to sprint and how to run over longer distances, developing their stamina and control. Towards the end of the term, they will begin preparing for Sports Day events, building confidence and teamwork ready for Term 6.

Science

This term in Science, we will be exploring animals further. We will revisit mammals, reptiles, and fish, and learn about which animals are carnivores, herbivores, and omnivores.

Art

This term in Art, we will be looking at the artist 'Monet'. Children will explore the technique of 'tache' and will use their existing colour mixing skills to carefully design their own 'Waterlily Bridge'.

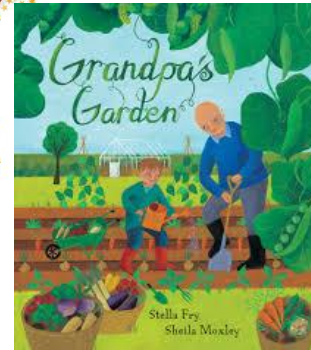
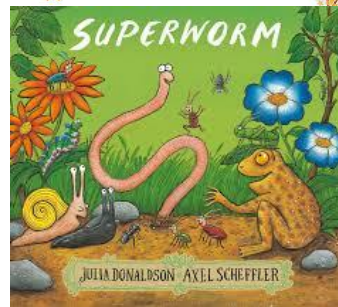


Mathematics

This term in Maths, we will be looking at measuring length and height, and exploring multiplication and division through arrays. Children will practise counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s, and will take part in a range of activities to help build confidence and deepen their understanding of these concepts.

English

This term, we will be looking at the books *Superworm* and *Grandpa's Garden*. We will be learning to use the suffix 'est' to compare things and will recap using the suffix 'ed'. The children will continue to develop their independent writing and begin to edit their own work. We will also be retelling the story of *Superworm* and writing instructions linked to *Grandpa's Garden*, helping to build confidence and creativity in their writing.

Religious Education

We will be learning about the Shabbat and how it is important to Jewish children. We will learn about what happens in the Shabbat.

PSHE

In PSHE this term we explore relationships. We will be discovering how families come in different shapes and sizes. We will discuss the importance of identifying conflict and how to resolve that.

History

In History this term we will be learning about 'David Attenborough'. We will be exploring who he is, why he is famous and the impact he has had on the world around us.

Geography

This term in Geography, the children will be learning about aerial maps. They will explore an aerial map of Moredon Primary School and will go on to create their own aerial maps of our classroom.
