The children are also expected to work on their times tables recall every night. Your child will sit the national Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) during the first two weeks of Term 6. Please continue to practise the recall of times tables as this will make calculations in Years 5 and 6 easier.

If you would like your child to have a snack at break time, please provide a healthy snack such as fruit or vegetables e.g carrot sticks, apple, banana.

PE kits need to be bought into school and kept into school for the term. Here is a reminder of the school's PE kit expectations:

- White t-shirt (plain or small logo)
- Black shorts, jogging bottoms or leggings (plain or small logo)
- Black sweatshirt (plain or small logo or school uniform sweatshirt/cardigan is fine)

- No jewellery (earrings removed or covered with tape)
