Welcome to Term 1 in Year 6! We hope that you all had a lovely summer holidays and are excited to be back at school.

Doors will be open from 8.30am, with the register being taken at 8.35am sharp. School will finish at 3:30pm Monday - Thursday and 1:30pm on Fridays. We would like to stress the importance of children's punctuality and attendance in Year 6, as this is really important for your child's learning.
