Welcome back for Term 3. We hope you had a wonderful Christmas break and are ready for the start of a brand-new year!

Our topic for this term is 'Romans and Celts' in which we will be looking at and exploring the Roman empire and how this changed England. For English, we will be using the text 'The Man Who Walked Between the Towers' to inspire our narrative and non-fiction writing. We have lots of exciting things planned for this term including creating Roman mosaics in art.

Children are expected to read their banded books every night to ensure they keep up their fluency and understanding. We will give pupils a new book to read once they have finished the one they are currently reading. They should practise their times tables daily. The children are expected to complete weekly maths homework which will be sent home on Fridays and expected in by the following Thursday, as well as spelling homework which can be accessed on EDSHED. PE for both classes will be on a Monday and Thursday for the rest of the year. Please make sure that children have a full PE kit in school in line with our PE kit policy (white top, black short/joggers, and a black jumper).
