Here are some ideas to complete for homework this term.

When you have finished a piece of homework you could send it to us on Class Dojo (You can upload documents as well as photos)

- Make a dinosaur. You could draw, paint, collage, make a junk model, use lego or why not to make biscuits or a cake! What else could you use?
- Go on a walk around the local area and see what animals you can see. Can you name them and identify their features?
- Play a board game with your family. Throw two dice and add up the numbers to see how many spaces you can move. You could make it harder by multiplying the two numbers! You could even make your own board game to play.
- Look at the Year One and Two Common Exception Words that we are sending home. Can you read them all? How many can you spell? Practise them in lots of different ways - you could paint them, make them from playdough, chalk on the patio, make them out of lego. How else could you practice them?
- Make your own obstacle course. Using garden equipment. Time yourself and try to beat you own personal best. Remember to take a picture or video to share with the class.
