According to evidence from the EEF, Overall, the average impact of arts participation on other areas of academic learning appears to be positive but moderate, about an additional three months progress.	We will track the children's progress from their starting points. The nursery and reception teachers will make regular assessments of where the children are. Pupil progress meetings will occur regularly throughout the year and gaps identified.
